

'Ship Ahoy!' promotes key skills such as listening and concentration, which also offering a fun physical warm up for EAL students.

Whilst this activity is suitable for all ages, it involves specialist vocabulary that the children may struggle to understand.

The exercise should last about five minutes, and it requires a large space.

Instructions:

- 1) Arrange the pupils in a line in front of the ship.
- 2) The pupils then have a number of commands that they need to respond to:

'Captain's Coming!' = Stand and salute

'Boom Crossing!' = Duck

'Scrub the Deck!' = Scrub the Floor

'Climb the Rigging!' = Pretend to climb

'Port!' = Go to the left of the room

'Starboard!' = Go to the right of the room

'Bow!' = Go to the front of the room
